# NBCD SLAM OVERVIEW BACKGROUND

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- **NBCD SLAM consolidates and regionally locates Marine Corps Nuclear, Biological, and Chemical Defense Equipment (NBCDE) under a single management concept and operation.**
- **ALMAR 070/03 established that effective 24 November 2003, the Marine Corps consolidated NBCDE funding, acquisition, and management under the Program Manager (PM) for NBCDE, Marine Corps Systems Command.**



# NBCD SLAM OVERVIEW THE "SOLUTION"

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**Enhance operational force capabilities by centrally managing NBCDE in order to establish an immediate and sustainable state of readiness in conjunction with constitution**



# NBCD SLAM OVERVIEW THE "HOW"

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- **NBCDE management, sustainment, and replacement authority transferred to PM NBCD**
- **Regional MEF, local Marine Corps Base consolidated storage using third-party logistics support**
- **Contingency NBCDE stocks prioritized**
- **Minimum training allowance held by units**
- **NBCDE visibility tells you:**
  - what's on-hand,
  - what's on-order, and
  - what's being fielded



- **Initial inventory visibility available to consolidated units through NBCD tracker for planning/readiness reporting**

# NBCD SLAM OVERVIEW SUMMARY

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- **Consolidation of NBCDE**
  - Ensures on-hand serviceability, visibility and accountability
  - Enhances support for operational requirements
  - Levels procurement funding
- **MARFORs know current and forecasted readiness by having visibility of what's on-hand, what's on-order, and what's being fielded**
- **Project is tracking to deliberate CSF rollout to ensure uninterrupted service to the MARFORs**

# NBCD SLAM COORDINATION

## Supply Requisitioning Procedures

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- **Deployed units will requisition items in accordance with current procedures.**
- **Units not supported by a CSF or a SASSY Management Unit will submit all requests for NBCDE and repair parts in MILSTRIP format using the NBCD Tracker**
  - Document numbers will be assigned by the units to requisition items. This will allow the units to track the status of their open requisitions in WEBVLIPS or Defense Supply Expert (DESX) DOD requisition tracking systems.
  - PM NBCD funds all NBCD requirements.
- **Note: If the unit requisitions items directly from the SOS, UNIT FUNDS will be expended. PM, NBCD will pay for all NBCD equipment placed on order using the NBCD tracker.**



# NBCDE VISIBILITY REQUIREMENT



- **PM NBCD REQUIRES INVENTORY ACCOUNTABILITY, AND VISIBILITY OF ALL NBCDE IN THE MARINE CORPS**
- **UNITS & PARTICIPATING COMMANDS NOT SUPPORTED BY A CSF NEED TO PROVIDE THEIR INVENTORY ACCOUNTABILITY INFORMATION TO THE PM NBCD FOR REPORTING AND PLANNING PURPOSES**
- **UNITS & PARTICIPATING COMMANDS REQUIRE REPORTING DATA FOR ALL NBCDE ASSIGNED TO THEM**





# NBCDE VISIBILITY DEFINITION



- **Ability to report the status of NBCD equipment for:**
  - Fielding Plans
  - On-Hand Inventory (All AACs supported by CSFs)
    - *Storage*
    - *Maintenance*
    - *Issued/Deployed*
  - On-Order Inventory
    - *Due-In Requisitions*
  - Locally managed NBCDE inventory
    - *Albany, Barstow, BIC*
    - *Others (Security Guard Bn, CBIRF, etc.)*

# NBCDE VISIBILITY NBCD TRACKER

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- **The NBCD Tracker will facilitate:**
  - Unit visibility of data for assets “on-hand” and “in the barn” for a complete picture of NBCDE status
  - Data export capability for use in external analysis and reporting tools
- **Advantages**
  - Provides current and accurate NBCDE information
  - Prevents direct manipulation of the data by the unit
  - Provides the ability to print reports or download the data in ASCII text file formats



# NBCD SLAM COORDINATION Summary & Way Forward

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- **Current DEMP (15 Sept)**
- **Baseline DEMP inclusive of maintenance, calibration, and shelf-life data (22 Sept)**
- **NBCD Tracker request forms (13 Sept)**
- **NBCD Tracker Training (xx Sept)**
- **Intermediate / Depot Maintenance funding**
- **Unit specific requirements?**
  - Operational requirement for each unit



# Stand-alone Units



- **Unserviceable equipment swap from CLNC CSF supportability ("one for one")**
  - IPE
  - Organizational equipment
  - Approach depends on
    - *Equipment density*
    - *Appropriate chain of command approvals*
- **Becomes a 'request'**
  - Urgency of need, command approvals, will dictate whether the item is filled from CSF stocks and backordered to replace; or requisitioned by SLAM PMO with associated lead times and delivered to unit.



## CBIRF-specific

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- **Provide 'tether' requirements (1 hour IRF, 4 hour IRF, and 3<sup>rd</sup> IRF TBD)**
- **Provide associated TE / TO to IRF**
- **Provide calibration facilities POC used**
  - M41 PATS – Redstone
  - Others – Quantico
- **Immediate requirement to refill 'live-training' gear expenditures**
- **Block II investigation needs to address COTS gear and associated contractor products and services**
- **Special allowances (type II, etc.)**



# MCSF Bn-specific



- **Supporting outlying commands**
  - FPM / IPE to support IAs
  - HQ Company - LANT
- **Recurring replacement of damaged equipment**
- **Security Force Companies**
  - Special requirements
  - CONUS
    - *MCSF Bn will re-supply*
    - *two platoons on 24-hr standby*
  - OCONUS - TBD



# MSG (1201 Marines)

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- **MSG is a state of deployment all the time**
- **Sustainment support (expiry of canisters per TI)**
- **Repair parts approach**
- **Replenishment & replacement ("normal" use & percentage of 'reacts')**
- **Shipping costs and surety of delivery to 136 locations (going to 159 locations). This means an upside of 250+ Marines.**
- **Inspections are twice per year**
