



NBCD SLAM CMC Update *19 August 2004*

Effective 24 Nov 2003, the Marine Corps consolidated NBCDE funding, acquisition, and management under the PM NBCD, MARCORSYSCOM per ALMAR 070/03. The NBCD Strategic Logistics Asset Management (SLAM) effort relieves operational units from garrison NBCD equipment storage and maintenance responsibilities by employing contractor logistics support (CLS) to manage unit NBCD equipment inventories from 12 regional consolidated storage facilities (CSFs). This effort best supports NBCD equipment readiness, accountability, visibility, unit responsiveness, and level funding while allowing units to focus on NBCD equipment training integration.

PM NBCD employed New Breed Corporations as the CLS contractor. The project is in the CSF activation phase. The Camp Lejeune CSF has been activated and 2nd MarDiv (garrisoned units) have been consolidated. The MarForRes CSF activates on 30 Aug 04. By year end, 7 of the 12 CSFs will have initiated operations, with all CSFs operational by May 2005. The NBCD SLAM project management office (PMO) has commenced management operations in Quantico, VA. The NBCD SLAM PMO is the focal point for all NBCDE functions including program management, funding, acquisition, and asset visibility for all operational and supporting Commands across the Marine Corps enterprise.
