THE PROGRAM MANAGER, NMCI/ITI, IN COORDINATION WITH HQMC C4, IS HOSTING A USMC NMCI ENTERPRISE CONFERENCE TO BE HELD 2-3 DECEMBER 2003 AT THE HOLIDAY INN SUPERDOME IN NEW ORLEANS, LA FOR ALL NMCI USERS WITHIN THE MARINE FORCES RESERVE REGION. THIS CONFERENCE IS THE FOURTH IN A SERIES OF REGIONAL CONFERENCES THAT WILL BE EXECUTED OVER THE NEXT SEVERAL MONTHS TO PROVIDE THE MARINE CORPS COMMUNITY WITH CURRENT NMCI TRANSITION INFORMATION. THIS

EVENT IS OPEN TO ALL USMC MILITARY AND CIVILIAN PERSONNEL.
