GENTEXT/REMARKS/1. THE PROGRAM MANAGER, NMCI/ITI, IN COORDINATION WITH HQMC C4, IS HOSTING A USMC NMCI ENTERPRISE CONFERENCE TO BE HELD 7-8 APRIL 2004 ABOARD MCB CAMP LEJEUNE, NC FOR ALL MARINES, SAILORS, AND CIVILIANS WITHIN THE EAST COAST REGION. THIS CONFERENCE IS THE NINTH IN A SERIES OF REGIONAL CONFERENCES THAT HAVE BEEN EXECUTED OVER THE PAST SEVERAL MONTHS TO PROVIDE THE MARINE CORPS COMMUNITY WITH CURRENT NMCI TRANSITION INFORMATION.

THIS EVENT IS RECOMMENDED FOR ALL USMC MILITARY AND CIVILIAN PERSONNEL STATIONED ABOARD MCB CAMP LEJEUNE, MCAS CHERRY POINT, MCAS NEW RIVER, AND SURROUNDING AREAS. CONTRACTOR SUPPORT PERSONNEL ASSISTING IN NMCI TRANSITION ACTIVITIES WILL BE PERMITTED TO ATTEND ON A SPACE AVAILABLE BASIS.

2. OBJECTIVES. THE OBJECTIVES OF THE SUBJECT CONFERENCE ARE TO:

- A. PRESENT THE LATEST HQMC POLICY AND GUIDANCE TO SUPPORT A SUCCESSFUL NMCI TRANSITION.
- B. PROVIDE CURRENT TRANSITION EXECUTION INFORMATION.
- C. PROVIDE NMCI TECHNICAL UPDATES.
- D. PROVIDE LESSONS LEARNED.
- E. PROVIDE A FORUM TO SUPPORT QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS VIA INTERACTION BETWEEN GENERAL USERS, TRANSITION PERSONNEL AND REPRESENTATIVES FROM PM NMCI/ITI, HQMC C4, AND EDS.

3. TARGET AUDIENCE. THE TARGET AUDIENCE FOR DAY ONE OF THE CONFERENCE WILL BE THE GENERAL USER. SINCE ALL MARINES, SAILORS, AND CIVILIANS ABOARD THE BASE AND THE SURROUNDING AREAS WILL EVENTUALLY BE UTILIZING THE NMCI NETWORK THEY ARE HIGHLY ENCOURAGED TO ATTEND THE CONFERENCE. DAY TWO OF THE CONFERENCE WILL TARGET ONLY THOSE PERSONNEL DIRECTLY INVOLVED IN NMCI REQUIREMENT IDENTIFICATION, CLIN SELECTION, TRANSITION ACTIVITIES, SERVICE DELIVERY, QUALITY ASSURANCE, AND PERFORMANCE MANAGEMENT. SPECIFICALLY INCLUDED IN THIS GROUP ARE PERSONNEL THAT APPROVE

REQUIREMENTS, BUDGETING PERSONNEL, CTRS, G6 PERSONNEL, G4 FACILITIES PERSONNEL, EKMS CUSTODIANS, AND INFRASTRUCTURE (BOTH INSIDE AND OUTSIDE CABLE PLANT) PERSONNEL.
