# Light Duty Glove Insert



## Description

- The Light Duty Glove Insert is designed to be worn alone or under the Light Duty Work Glove (black leather).
- Replaces the current green polyester/lycra insert.
- Intent is to eliminate the melt/drip hazard by changing to a cotton/lycra insert.

## Acquisition Strategy

- DSCP's solicitation for a small buy for 20K units closed on April 18, 2008.
- Purchase description was finalized in April 2008 to be used in the solicitation for a large buy.
- Awaiting NSN's to be assigned.
- DSCP's contract award for a large buy is scheduled to be within 6 - 8 months after NSN's are assigned.

## Fielding

- Definite quantities TBD, will be a CIF item.

## Sustainment Concept

- CIF item issued to the entire Marine Corps, sustained through DSCP.

- Waiting for NSN's to be assigned so that the procurement for the large buy can begin.





# Light Duty Glove Insert

## *Future*

---



- Investigate if two sizes (Sm/Med & Lrg/XL) will be sufficient, or if a 3<sup>rd</sup> size needs to be added.
- Continue to look for material improvements that provide:
  - No melt/drip
  - Water resistance & quick dry
  - Breathability/comfort
  - Good tactility/dexterity, and grip
  - Durability
